

## Varsity Letter Requirements:

Beginning in 2016-17 requirements for Varsity Letter will be documented over 4 years and when you have earned the appropriate amount of points, you will be honored with a Band Varsity Letter in May of that year. Varsity letters are for participation in activities around band, no bearing on letter grade for class. Class grade will be more of an evaluation of your music skills. A varsity letter is a reflection of your hours of commitment given to the organization.

5.0 pts. Total number points needed for musicians

3.0 pts. Total numbers of points needed for color guard.

How to earn points:

A Complete school year of participation Marching	2 points
A Complete school year of participation Concert / Symphonic Winds	2 points
Preparing and performing a solo at an SCSBOA Adjudicated Event	1 point
Taking Private lessons each year of high school. (You will submit a form to your teacher for verification)	1 point
Perfect Attendance at all band rehearsals This is any dates scheduled starting the last week of July until school starts. (Any absence that is excused is not applied, but must be properly documented)	1 point
Application and AUDITION for an Honor Band position.	1 point
Acceptance and participation in an Honor Band you applied for. (such as: SCSBOA, ACVHB, CMEA, or All-State)	2 points
Member of the Jazz Band, when offered.	1 point
Member of the Winter Colorguard	1 point

Subsequent years will receive a chevron notating an additional year meeting the requirements. Students will receive an insert denoting Band and/or Colorguard
